



ACE OF TRUMPS GRENACHE

McLaren Vale | 2020



Our bush vine Grenache is contour planted on a south facing slope overlooking the ocean in the Seaview sub region of McLaren Vale. The vines are selectively hand pruned, shoot thinned and hand harvested. This medium bodied wine is delicate and asserts great purity of fruit with remarkable structure and balance.

Fresh raspberries and dark cherry fruit aromas mingle with sweet cinnamon spice and delicate vanilla and clove aromas. Intriguing and inviting, an immediately satisfying wine that swiftly covers the palate. Before release it is matured in French oak puncheons for 12 months (30% new) and then a period in bottle.

Cellar for 5-10 years.

Ace of Trumps is a tribute to my family's racehorse, which won the Adelaide cup in 1874.

Bush vine Grenache from Chapel Hill Road. Pretty, raspberried, sweet-seeming aromatics and flavours but with just enough savoury-spiciness to keep it in check. Firm tannin but the juiciness of the fruit ripples through it. Decent quality. Lots of woody spice notes. Light, but it makes it work.
