



ANNA'S SAUVIGNON BLANC

Adelaide Hills | 2025



Brilliant light yellow with bright green hues. Fresh passionfruit and snow pea fragrance, with hints of citrus and nutty French oak. The palate has light tropical fruit flavours, citrus fruit, lovely crisp acid and mineral notes, with a very subtle silky texture.

A very delicate cool climate style of Sauvignon Blanc with fresh passionfruit flavours, refreshing acidity and fine silky texture from barrel ageing. Made with a big nod to French tradition and to be paired with your favourite seafood.

The 2025 vintage carries a sublime nose of lemon blossom and slate minerality, with just a hint of grass. It transitions to the signature creamy early tropical fruits of the Anna's Block on the palate, coupled with lemon-lime, soft grapefruit, and nuances of melons and white peach. The finish is long and textured by time on lees balanced by refreshing crunchy acidity.

Karrawatta Anna's shows all the summer signals without going full Kiwi zone. Light and refreshing, with passionfruit, grassy aromatics, and just a hint of texture that gives it length rather than a quick, sharp finish. Gentle enough to start the afternoon, but not so simple that you forget it.

Drink this in the middle of the day, wearing your hat at a barbecue with some asparagus on your fork... or with your feet in a wading pool under an umbrella, being poured for you. No food required, but it won't complain if prawns or some earthy greens show up.
