



**CHRISTO'S PADDOCK
CABERNET SAUVIGNON**
Langhorne Creek | 2017



A small parcel of fruit from old vines next to the Angas River was hand selected for our Cabernet. Bunches were selectively picked, crushed and left on skins for seven days. The wine was aged for 18 months in a combination of 35% new and old French oak barrels.

This is an outstanding example of Cabernet Sauvignon with a classic ripe palate with strong blackcurrant red fruit flavours balanced by fresh acidity and sweet, noble, velvety, drying and satisfying tannins. Drink now or cellar for 20+ years.

Deepish red/purple colour, with a subtle red and blue fruit aroma, which turns deliciously sweet-fruited in the mid-palate and has elegance as well as length. The wine is bright and fruity, intense and focused, with penetrating length and oodles of charm. An impressive wine.
