



CHRISTO'S PADDOCK GRAND VIN CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Langhorne Creek | 2019



Our Christo's Paddock vineyard is managed using sensitive farming practices and organic principles. Specially selected grapes from selected vines, this portion of the vineyard is hand manicured from pruning through to shoot and fruit thinning to produce a very special parcel of grapes.

The Grand Vin Christo's Paddock Cabernet Sauvignon is a more rich and fuller bodied style of wine compared to the Christo's Paddock Cabernet Sauvignon. It is selected from rows in the vineyard where the grapes ripen a little more and it also has slightly more new French oak.

Bright ruby red with deep magenda hues. Rich black currant and ripe dark cherry aromas mingle with cedary and spicy French oak. Already rich, ripe and complex. A very opulent style Cabernet Sauvignon palate with very strong fruit intensity in the middle palate. Lovely deep tannin structure which is firm but not aggressive. Balanced acidity combines with the tannins to give the wine a drying, pleasing and very long finish. A full bodied wine with ripe harmonious primary fruit flavours but also an acid and tannin structure that will suit long ageing. Cellar for up to 10-15 years.
