



DAIRY BLOCK SHIRAZ

Adelaide Hills | 2021



Selectively picked from our low-yielding Shiraz vines, which grow on the north facing slope of our Sophie's Hill vineyard. Yields were extremely low, but quality was excellent with amazing balance and structure. Vivid colours of mid ruby with a deep brick red hue. The wine was fermented on skins for 9 days and aged for 18 months in 25% new French oak barrels. Pretty sweet fruit, blackberry, black pepper, plums, dried herbs, oak on finish. Savoury and balanced. Definite 'Rhone' style.

Look here if seeking full-throttle shiraz with a contemporary sheen of classy oak, polish, concentration and despite the obvious heft, Rhone-inspired aromatics of purple fruits, dried nori, brine, charcuterie.
