



JOSEPH SHIRAZ

Langhorne Creek | 2017



Small berries, low yields and open bunches characterise the Shiraz grown on Christo's Paddock vineyard. These old vines produce grapes with great flavour intensity and richness. Once fermentation was complete the wine was gently pressed into a combination of new (40%) and old French oak barrels, where it matured for 18 months. Expect red and black berries, coffee and liquorice with a savoury edge and grippy tannins providing great structure, length and age-ability. Cellar for 20 + years.

From the family's vineyard, matured for 18 months in French oak. Interesting wine, with a distinctly savoury edge, dark chocolate a la McLaren Vale and a long palate. The colour is bright crimson, and the wine will live as long as your patience.
