



JOSEPH SHIRAZ

Langhorne Creek | 2019



Small berries, low yields and open bunches characterise the Shiraz grown on Christo's Paddock vineyard. These old vines produce grapes with great flavour intensity and richness. After fermentation the wine was gently pressed into a combination of new (33%) and old French oak barrels, where it matured for 18 months.

Vivid, deep ruby red appearance. Intense, very fresh ripe raspberry and blackcurrant aromas, concentrated spice and attractive cedary oak notes. Great flavour intensity of rich red and black berries, coffee and dark chocolate. Soft velvety tannins. Great structure, length and age-ability. Cellar for 20+ years.

Deeply set dark fruits, with regionally typical mocha/dark chocolate feels around the flavour bubble. Give this some air and it rises, while a layer of flint and earthiness sets a solid foundation.

This is not the standard inky Langhorne Shiraz in the glass - bright and lively - as red as it is purple. Quality French oak leads the nose - only just ahead of a lovely mix of ripe purple, red and blue berries. A delicately fruited wine with aromatic lift. Spice speaking quietly in the background. When sipped, the front palate bursts with the breadth of juicy and plush berries, rolling into the mid palate and tapering to soft tannins and dark cherry acidity. It's a beautiful Shiraz.
