



JOSEPH SHIRAZ

Langhorne Creek | 2020



Small berries, low yields and open bunches characterise the Shiraz grown on Christo's Paddock vineyard. These old vines produce grapes with great flavour intensity and richness. After fermentation the wine was gently pressed into a combination of new (33%) and old French oak barrels, where it matured for 18 months.

Vivid, deep ruby red appearance. Intense, very fresh ripe raspberry and blackcurrant aromas, concentrated spice and attractive cedary oak notes. Great flavour intensity of rich red and black berries, coffee and dark chocolate. Soft velvety tannins. Great structure, length and age-ability. Cellar for 20 + years.

Langhorne Creek shiraz muscle on full display here. Deep, darkly fruited style all the way with some noticeable alcohol and cedary oak, enlivened on the middle palate by the arrival of vanilla and baking spices.

AUSTRALIAN WINE COMPANION 2023

Deep and pure ruby-red colour. Preserved mulberry and broken slate aromas. Blackberry fruits fill the front-palate, evolving to a more savoury mid-palate of black slate and wood spices. The tannins caress it throughout and it moves to a long finish with notes of oak chocolate and vanilla in abundance.
