



NIMBLEFOOT PINOT NOIR

Adelaide Hills | 2024



This wine is delicate and reflects its true sense of place. The vines are hand-manicured and grow in rocky soils on the coolest south-facing slopes at our Sophie's Hill vineyard (alt. 480m).

Made from multiple clones (MV6 and French clones 114, 115 and 777), it is matured in new and seasoned French barriques.

The 2024 vintage displays aromas of delicate violet, cherry, rosemary and pretty pomegranate. This follows through to a fine palate, nuanced with sour cherry, hints of liquorice, subtly smoky oak and fine, rolling tannins.

Nimblefoot is a tribute to the horse that won the 1870 Melbourne Cup, of which Joseph Gilbert's horse Lapdog ran a close second, after being ridden from Adelaide to Melbourne.

Deep crimson, with a perfumed nose of redcurrant confectionery, florals, and clove oak. Light-bodied on the palate, savoury with zesty acidity and a Campari-like amaro bitterness. Bright and elegant.
