



SOPHIE'S HILL PINOT GRIGIO

Adelaide Hills | 2025



Our Pinot Grigio is planted at the highest point in the vineyard, at an altitude of approximately 480 metres above sea level, where it enjoys cool nights and shade from the afternoon sun - ideal for premium Grigio production. The juice is barrel-fermented in old French barriques and goes through partial malo-lactic fermentation.

Elegant, effortless, and refreshing on the palate, the 2025 Sophie's Hill Pinot Grigio opens with lively aromas of spiced pear, green apple, white blossom, and lemony citrus. Wet-stone minerality, crisp pithy acidity, and hints of white blossom and grapefruit dance across the palate, while partial malo and lees contact add texture, depth, and subtle complexity, the result of delicate and considered winemaking.

Light yellow hue; intriguing spice aromas, background floral and creamy lees nuances. Intense in the mouth, with refreshing acidity and a clean, dry, appetising finish and aftertaste. Good length: a benchmark for pinot grigio.
