



CHRISTO'S PADDOCK
CABERNET SAUVIGNON
LANGHORNE CREEK | 2016



A small parcel of fruit from old vines next to the Angas River was hand selected for our Cabernet. Bunches were selectively picked, crushed and left on skins for seven days. The wine was aged for 18 months in a combination of 35% new and old French oak barrels. Drink now as a young, assertive Cabernet showing layers of flavour including blackcurrant, cassis, plum, mint, cedary oak and fine-grained, chewy tannins, or cellar for 20 + years.



Deep red colour with a good purple tint. The aromas are crushed-leafy and berry-like, with sappy and slightly grippy tannins. It's quite aromatic. An intense, full-bodied cabernet, with solid tannins and a touch of elegance. It's cellarworthy.
