



SOPHIE'S HILL PINOT GRIGIO

ADELAIDE HILLS | 2019



Our Pinot Grigio is planted at the highest point in the vineyard, at an altitude of approximately 520 metres above sea level, where it enjoys cool nights and shade from the afternoon sun - ideal for premium Grigio production. We aim to make a wine that is delicate, lifted and versatile. The juice is barrel-fermented in old French barriques and goes through partial malo-lactic fermentation, which has resulted in a complex flavour profile and soft, generous mouthfeel. Primary characters of pear, grapefruit, green apple and chamomile combine with refreshing acidity and great length on the palate.

'Very light yellow colour with a nougat, vanilla, cashew nut bouquet, the wine full and soft and rounded, with fullness and grip, the finish resonant, savoury, dry and long. It seems to have some barrel involvement, and this has been done very well.'
