



**THE MEDDLER
MALBEC**
LANGHORNE CREEK | 2017



Handcrafted Malbec from our 'Christo's Paddock' vineyard in Langhorne Creek. A small parcel of fruit was selected from a block of 10 year old vines on ultra premium dirt, just off the Angas River. The wine was barrel-aged for 16 months in new and seasoned French barriques. It's loaded with perfume, is intensely purple, plush and elegant, with soft tannins and bold flavours that marry beautifully with rich dishes like charry lamb on the barbecue, or your favourite slow-cooked dinner.

Malbec from Langhorne Creek. Not a wine to argue with svelte and smooth for sure but boy does this serve up some flavour. Strap yourself in. Leather, blackberry pie, malt and fresh cedarwood flavours sweep through the palate. There's tannin here but it has largely melted into the fruit; there's a hit of aniseed; there's some alcohol warmth; there a suggestion of gum leaf. The flavours are here and they are wide open.
