



THE MEDDLER MALBEC

Langhorne Creek | 2019



Handcrafted Malbec from our 'Christo's Paddock' vineyard in Langhorne Creek. A small parcel of fruit was selected from a block of 10 year old vines on ultra premium dirt, just off the Angas River. The wine was barrel-aged for 16 months in new and seasoned French barriques.

Bright dark ruby red with deep magenda hues. Vibrant fresh, rich blueberry and plum aromas with some hints of blackcurrant and slight spicy cedary French oak. Rich, yet tightly wound and will become more expressive with more bottle ageing.

Lovely, very robust wine showing deep red fruit flavours of plum, blueberry and raspberry. Immediately pleasing on the mid palate as the ripe red fruit flavours impress, then these sensations are quickly reined in as pleasing tannins and acid flow over the palate to give a dry lingering mouthfeel.

Deep red/purple colour, with an aroma of licorice, aniseed and dark-berry fruits. The wine is medium to full-bodied and quite supple for a young malbec: soft-textured and even mellow—which translates as approachable in youth. The palate is again licoricey and ripe, rich and powerful, with abundant tannins but they're smooth ripe tannins, not astringent. It is fairly straightforward but delivers lashings of rich, very ripe fruit flavour. Cellar until 2029.
