



ANTH'S GARDEN CHARDONNAY

Adelaide Hills | 2021



Handcrafted Chardonnay from our vineyard, planted at high altitude above Meadows in the Adelaide Hills.

Hand-picked and gently whole-bunch pressed to retain natural flavour and complexity. A portion of the juice went directly into old French barriques for full solids, wild fermentation, while the remainder was shared between a combination of old and new French oak barriques and puncheons, in order to build complexity and texture.

The 2021 vintage offers fresh citrus, pineapple and white stone fruit characters that combine with subtle nutty/smokey/struck match barrel ferment notes. Refreshing lime and white peach flavours mingle with mineral acid characters and a pleasing light creamy texture and a crisp acid finish.

Very pale lemon, touch of lime in the light. Lime blossom and green apple aromatics. Subtle and fresh apple fruits on the palate with a gossamer net of acidity that gently guides the fruit across the palate. Good length, staying vibrant and lifted with floral notes lingering at the finish.
